ROTARY DISTRICT 5330 – MUSIC COMPETITION RULES FOR CONTESTANTS



The 25th annual District 5330 Rotary Music Competition provides an introductory platform for high school musicians to perform and for many to enhance career opportunities.

PRIZES

There are three contest categories – **Vocal, Instrumental** and **Piano**. Prizes may be available at the club level and selected performers are entered into the District Finals by the local Club(s). Recognition for all participant finalists is given at the District Finals and prizes for winners in each category are awarded at as follows:

1st Place - \$1,000, 2nd Place - \$500, 3rd Place - \$250

APPLICATION

Only high school students (or home-schooled students) living within Rotary District 5330 are eligible to enter the Rotary Music Competition. Students should be within the area served by their local Rotary club(s).

Entries to the **District Finals** will be paid for by the local club the student is representing and must be received by the District Music Competition chair on or before Friday, February 28, 2025.

Applications may be obtained from the Music Competition chairperson of the local Rotary club(s) hosting a competition. Contestants may not enter more than one local competition. Prior first place winners in the District Competition and not eligible to compete.

REPERTOIRE

The contestant will perform one or more pieces in the competition. Pianists and instrumentalists must play at least one piece of **classical music**. Additional pieces will be the contestant's choice.

Singers must perform songs from musical theater or classical music.

Judges will not accept songs from the country western, popular, jazz, and Christian music genres at this competition.

For instrumental and piano performances, the entire audition should be 5 to 8 minutes and should not exceed 10 minutes. For vocal performances, the entire audition is 4 to 6 minutes and should not exceed 8 minutes. Extremely short pieces may be penalized at the discretion of the judges.

<u>Pieces must be memorized</u> for the District Finals. Sheet music may be used at the local competition.

ROTARY DISTRICT 5330 – MUSIC COMPETITION RULES FOR CONTESTANTS

JUDGING

The performance will be judged by professional musicians and may include critique and feedback to help the contestant improve. The evaluation will be scored based on four criteria:

1. Tone Quality

Voice: Vocal Quality, Breath Control Tonal Control, Pitch

Instrumentalists: Beauty of Sound Breath Control, Tuning, Instrument Quality

Piano: Style, Touch Quality, Pedal Control

2. Technique

Note Accuracy, Difficulty of Music, Articulation, Precision Rhythmic Accuracy

3. Interpretation

Phrasing, Style, Tempo Expression

4. General Effect

Stage Presence, Showmanship, Memorization, Time or length of piece.

A printed copy of the score or sheet music should be provided to each judge and should include, If possible, measures performed on the score be numbered so that judges can identify specific parts of the music for their comments.

EVENT TIMES

The local club(s) competition will be held prior to the District Finals. Winners must be available to participate in the District Finals and the Rotary Youth Showcase events listed below.

District Finals, will be held at: **University of Redlands**, **Frederick Loewe Performance Hall**, 1200 E. Colton Ave., Redlands CA 92374 at the following dates and times:

- Vocal competition Saturday, March 8, 2025 9:00 am to 12:30 pm.
- Instrumental competition Saturday, March 15, 2025 9:00 am to 12:30 pm.
- Piano competition Saturday, March 22, 2025 9:00 am to 12:30 pm.

District prizes of up to \$1,000 will be presented to the winning contestants and they will be expected to perform at the **Rotary Youth Showcase** event which will be held at: **Benedict Castle**, 5445 Chicago Avenue, Riverside CA 92507 – **Sunday, April 6, 2025** – **3:00 pm to 4:30 pm.**
